How to Register?

To be eligible, you must:

- Be unable to leave your home without difficulty, due to your age, illness, or disability.
- Not live in a facility where meals are provided.
- Not have someone—housemate, family member, caregiver or friend— who can regularly pick-up food for you at AIFC and bring it to you.
- Have a gross total household income lower than the level set by the US Department of Health and Human Services poverty guideline.
- Meet at your home with an AIFC volunteer to fill out the Registration Form.
- Be available to accept food deliveries once a month.
